Parties then interested in submitting an official bid shall contact Benesch (402-479-2200) and an official hard-copy spec booklet will be sent, at no cost, to the interested parties by Benesch. In order to submit a bid, Contractors must obtain an official hard-copy spec booklet from Benesch, as the electronic documents on the Engineer hosted FTP site do not contain the official bid booklet information.

No pre-bid conference will be held for the project.

Each proposal must be accompanied by a bid guaranty (per 49 CFR Part 18.36(h)(1)) in the amount of not less than five (5) percent of the total amount of the bid. The bid guaranty may be by certified check on a solvent bank or bid bond made payable to the Hall County Airport Authority, Grand Island, Nebraska.

All proposals submitted in accordance with the instructions presented herein will be subject to evaluation. Bids may be held by the Hall County Airport Authority for a period not to exceed **90 calendar days** for the purpose of evaluating bids prior to award of contract.

The award of contract will be based on the lowest aggregate sum proposal for the equipment item(s), submitted from those bidders that are confirmed as being responsive and responsible. The right is reserved, by the Hall County Airport Authority, to reject any and all bids and to waive any or all irregularities, technicalities, informality or any information in the bids received.

The successful bidder will **NOT** be required to furnish separate performance (per 49 CFR Part 18.36(h)(2)) and payment (per 49 CFR Part 18.36(h)(3)) bonds.

Federal Provisions

Each bidder shall be aware and acknowledge that the project is subject to the FAA's current Federal Provisions as listed in the Supplementary Provisions of the contract documents.
