#### **AIRCRAFT RESCUE FIRE FIGHTING (ARFF) PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:**

Ability to wear a self-contained breathing apparatus and face mask and perform duties in personal protective equipment. Heavy work, must be able to move objects weighing up to 100 lbs. or more such as fire hoses, air rescue firefighting equipment by lifting, carrying, pushing and pulling. Duties require frequent walking, standing, climbing, reaching, driving ARFF vehicles, operating machinery and handling of fuel and other hazardous material. Participate in annual ARFF training, including a live burn.
