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Allegiant Air Adds Extra Flight from Grand Island to Phoenix-Mesa Beginning in December

Grand Island, Neb. - The Hall County Airport Authority (HCAA) is pleased to announce Allegiant Air will be adding an extra flight each week from Grand Island to Phoenix-Mesa (AZA) beginning December 15, 2024, upping the total number of flights per week from two to three. Weekly flights to Phoenix-Mesa will jump to four beginning February 4, 2025.

Michael J. Olson, HCAA Executive Director, attributes the additional weekly frequencies to strong demand in the winter and spring. He said, "March and April are very busy travel months, especially to the Phoenix-Mesa area. Allegiant has added additional frequencies in the past to the Phoenix-Mesa area and they were very well received by travelers in Central Nebraska. We expect their additional frequencies to be equally successful this winter and spring."

Allegiant Air also flies twice weekly out of Grand Island to Las Vegas (LAS). American Airlines flies twice daily to Dallas/Ft. Worth (DFW) allowing Grand Island area residents access to almost anywhere in the world from the Central Nebraska Regional Airport.
